Watch out for photochemical smog!

Photochemical smog is generated in large quantities on days when the temperature exceeds 20 Celsius and there is only a light wind. Smog alerts and warnings will be announced through wireless stations for disaster prevention as well as on notice boards at public facilities. Official warnings will as a rule be valid until sunset.

When an alert or alarm is announced:

- Refrain from making unnecessary trips outdoors and exercising outdoors.

"Mitaka Kiwi Fruit Wine" is brewed from Mitaka-grown kiwi fruits in Otsuki-city, Yamanashi. This year, a special edition of the wine is on sale to celebrate Mitaka City's 60th anniversary. The special 60th anniversary label features Mitaka City's character "Poki," which anime filmmaker Hayao Miyazaki of Studio Ghibli designed. In connection with 60 years, a limited release of 6,000 bottles is on sale at about 60 liquor stores in the city. White and rosé wines are available. Both feature smooth, sweet, and fruity flavor with the slight sour taste of kiwi fruit. "Mitaka Kiwi Fruit Wine," first released 24 years ago, has become very popular. Please try the wine!

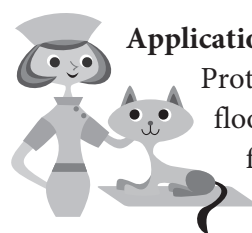

Reduction of sterilization/castration service fees for homeless cats

When homeless cats (6 months old or older) in the city undergo sterilization or castration at designated veterinary clinics, the fee is uniformly reduced by 5,000 yen (40 cats planned for this year). Operated by Tokyo Veterinary Medical Association, Musashino/Mitaka branch.

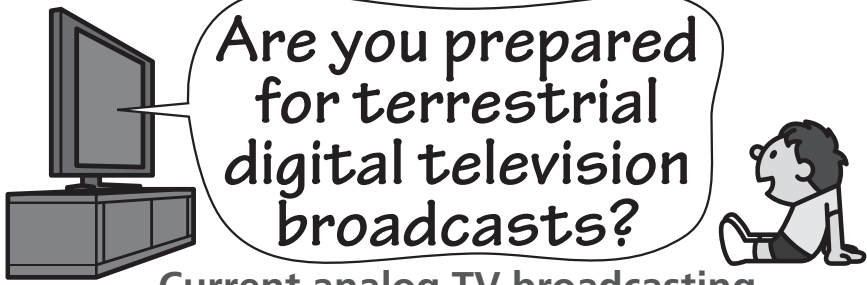

Current analog TV broadcasting will end on July 24, 2011!

The current analogue TV broadcast will end on July 24, 2011 and it will be completely switched over to terrestrial digital TV broadcast. After the change, those who have analogue TVs have to connect it to a terrestrial digital tuner, otherwise you cannot watch TV broadcasts (terrestrial digital TV broadcasts).

To be able to watch terrestrial digital TV

You have to prepare to be able to watch terrestrial digital TV with one of the options below:

1. Buy a terrestrial digital TV broadcast compatible TV (You need a UHF antenna).
2. Connect a terrestrial digital tuner to your current TV (You need a UHF antenna).
3. Watch TV broadcasts through cable TV.

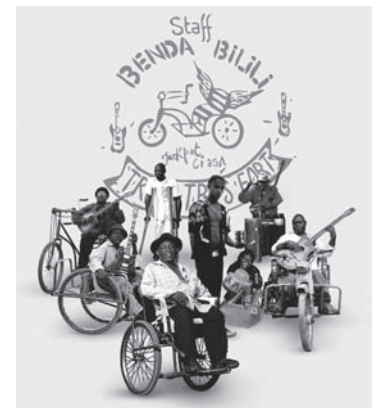
